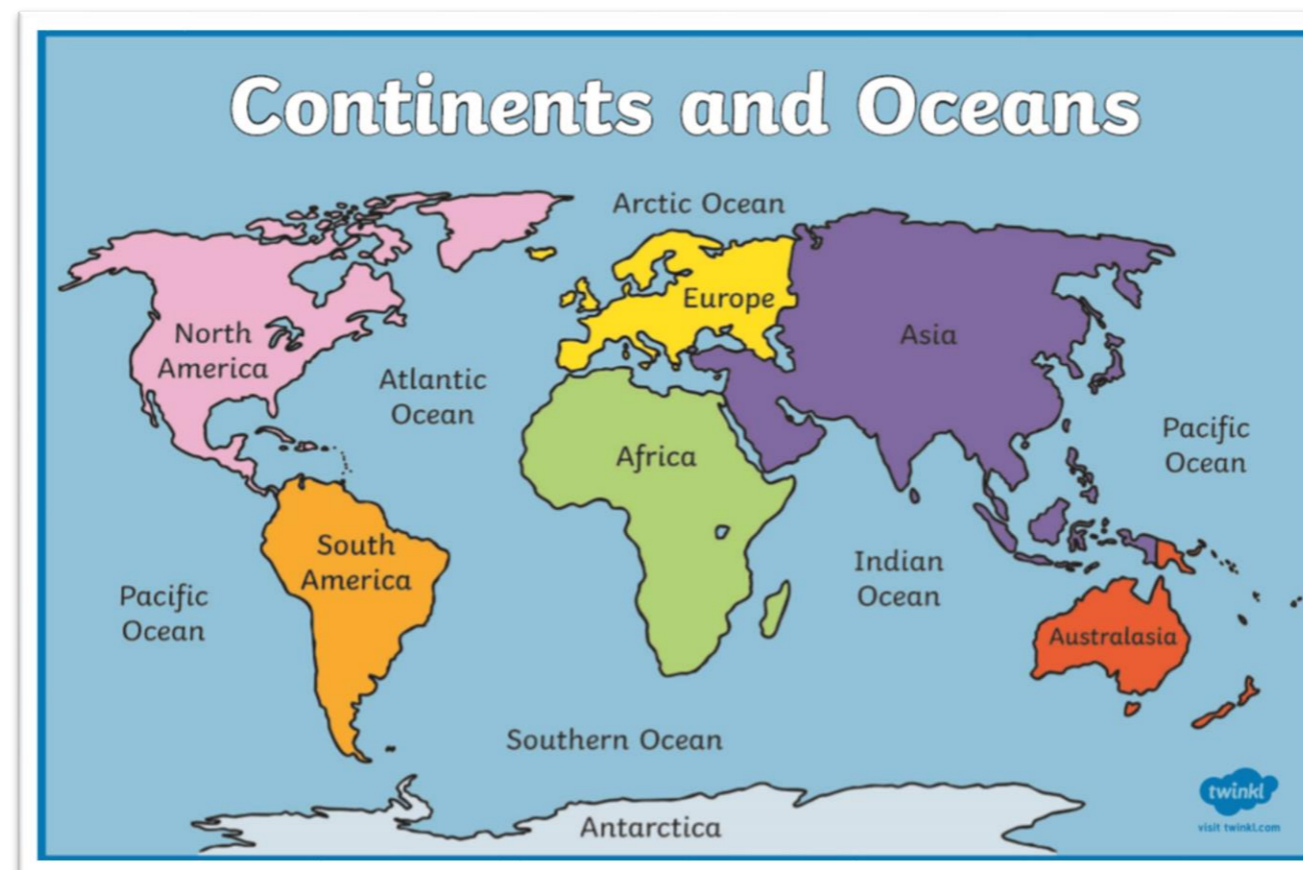
- What is home?

- Southern Ocean



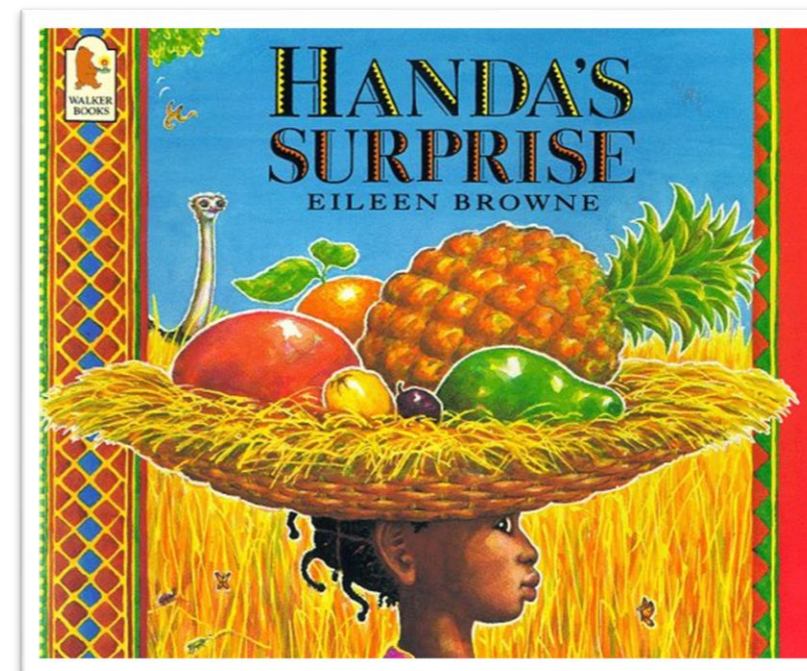
When we explore Bristol as a city, we will learn about different homes.
